

Update from our Risk Assessment Committee

We will be continuing our outdoor worship on the patio through the end of May and are preparing for indoor worship with the upcoming changes announced by the CDC (graphic below). We are currently scheduling a thorough cleaning of inside the meetinghouse in preparation for indoor worship. And, we hope to have new and stronger gazebos for our patio so we can continue to use our outdoor gathering space. We will be sure to announce when we may begin indoor worship. Below are reminders of what is in place for blended worship outside with Zoom for those who are worshipping from home. PLEASE check the website for updates under "Our Meeting."

Outdoor Worship

- Meeting for Worship will be held on the Outdoor Gathering Space behind the Meeting House. Enter the space from the sidewalk along the playground wall, using the ramp.
- Sign in at the podium, using one-time use pencils provided. Provide your name, phone number, and e-mail address.
- Bring a chair from home and place it at least 6 feet (two arms' lengths) on all sides from other chairs.
- The ADA bathroom (opposite the kitchen) will be available with entrance from the school side parking lot. Parents, please accompany children. With provided wipes, please sanitize all contact areas (toilet seat and flush handle, sink and faucets, inside and outside door knobs, etc.) before and after using the bathroom. Discard used wipes in the designated container(s).
- There will be no First Day School or supervised childcare. During Meeting for Worship, children may play on the lower playground near the gym (not by the Meeting House) and must be accompanied by an adult.
- At the rise of Meeting, greet each other with smiles and waves - no hugs or handshakes.
- After announcements, please exit the Gathering Space down the steps toward the blacktop and the school buildings. Accommodations will be made for anyone who cannot navigate the steps. Those wishing to remain and socialize, please do so on the blacktop or on the playground, using social distancing at all times.
